

Burleigh Elementary School – Dress Code

- Reference Elmbrook School Board Policy 5132 -

Footwear:

- For safety reasons gym style shoes must be worn daily for gym, indoor and outdoor recess (except for boots in winter) and any other physical activity deemed appropriate by staff.

Clothing:

- Midsections must be covered at all times (belly, sides and back).
- Undergarments shall be fully covered at all times.
- Hats may only be worn outside of the school building. (Excluding spirit days)
- Clothing should fit appropriately, neither too tight, baggy, or short.
- Clothes may not display images with tobacco, drugs, alcohol, weapons, vulgar language/pictures, may not be offensive to others, and may not advocate violations of school rules or the law.
- Other dress items not mentioned herein, but that are found to be disruptive to the learning environment or that pose a safety concern, will be addressed by school administration and staff.

Additional related policy items:

- Electronic devices should remain at home.

This complete dress code will be enforced during school hours, field trips, and school-sponsored extra-curricular events at school – including those school activities that occur outside of regular school hours.

Reminders:

First Time: A school dress code reminder will be sent home requiring a parent signature (temporary clothes issued by school if needed).

Second Time: Parent contact and issuance of temporary clothes by school, or parent may be required to bring in a change of clothes.

Third Time: Parent contact, clothing issued by school/brought by parent, and detention issued.
